ENTRY FEE

An entry fee of **\$300 plus GST** (\$337.50 total), per MALE entry **MUST** accompany the entry form. This fee is non-refundable after the entry closing date. Included in this fee is a promotional levy of \$100.00.

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS

- All Beef Expo entries must have been TB tested within 12 months prior to the sale in line with AHB requirements. Any Beef Expo entry coming from a movement control area must have been tested within 60 days as required by the AHB and have a clear status. All TB certificates must be lodged with the Hereford office not less than 48 hours prior to the commencement of the sale. **THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED WITHOUT EXCEPTION.** (One TB card per animal is required). The TB status will be displayed on pen cards.
- Ear Tagging – all cattle must be identifiable with current AHB/NZHA identification requirements.
- BVD vaccination is compulsory for all Beef Expo entries. All animals must be BVD antigen negative and have been vaccinated twice prior to the Expo sale. The vendor must declare this in writing accompanied by the vaccine batch number administered. This information must be lodged with the Hereford office no later than 48 hours prior to the sale.
- Vendors with multiple entries will be confirmed no later than 10 days after the close of entry.
- All Hereford Beef Expo entries (including Super Sires) will be inspected by persons appointed by the NZHA Council. The cost of inspection will be shared and invoiced to all those entered at the completion of inspection. Any animal failing to make the catalogue due to that inspection will have its entry fee refunded but will still be subject to any inspection fees. Any decisions to deny entry will be at the full discretion of NZHA based on the inspectors recommendations. That decision will be final.
- Sires of all Beef Expo entered animals must have been DNA profiled. Please ensure that any bulls that have been used at stud have the relevant DNA profile.

LED BULL CLASS

Entries may be limited to about 40 bulls (in total 20 in each class). Should there be the need to reduce entry numbers the Hereford Expo Committee has the right to limit studs to one led bull. **It is imperative exhibitors clearly identify their first choice of bull.**

UNLED BULL CLASS

Subject to the same conditions as Led bulls. Unled bull entries cannot be displayed on a halter.

A proof of each entry will be provided to you for review, as it will appear in the Expo Catalogue.
